



## 2015 Woodturning Contest Rules

**This contest is for all High School Students in NH and any out-of-state student who's school is participating in "Youth Day"**

1. Turned piece must have been turned in the 2014/15 school year and verified by the shop teacher.
2. Piece must be submitted at one of the High Schools hosting Youth Day on Friday, May 8th. These are Alvirne HS, Franklin HS, Hanover, HS, Kingwood Regional HS, Mascoma HS, Merrimack HS, Spaulding HS and Pinkerton Academy.
3. Piece can be anything turned on a woodturning lathe
4. Pieces will be displayed at the Woodturning symposium on Saturday, May 9th. They will have their own table in the instant gallery section.
5. Winners will be announced at the symposium lunch hour
6. Prizes: 1st place is the New Rikon 12X20 VSR mini lathe, 2<sup>nd</sup> place \$200 gift certificate and 3rd place a \$100 gift certificate.
7. All participants get a Guild of New Hampshire Woodworkers T-shirt.
8. Participants are required to be present when the winners are announced and pick up their pieces and prizes after the event unless a responsible party has been assigned by them in writing. Participants can attend Saturday's Symposium for free!
9. Piece must be clearly labeled identifying the turner
10. Submitted piece must include a completed entry form
11. Limit of one turned object per student
